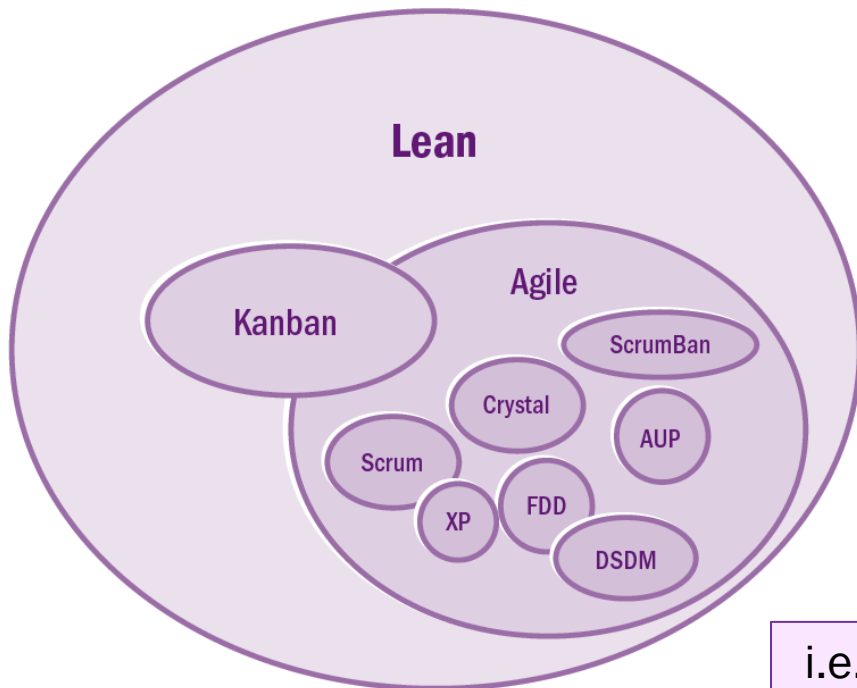

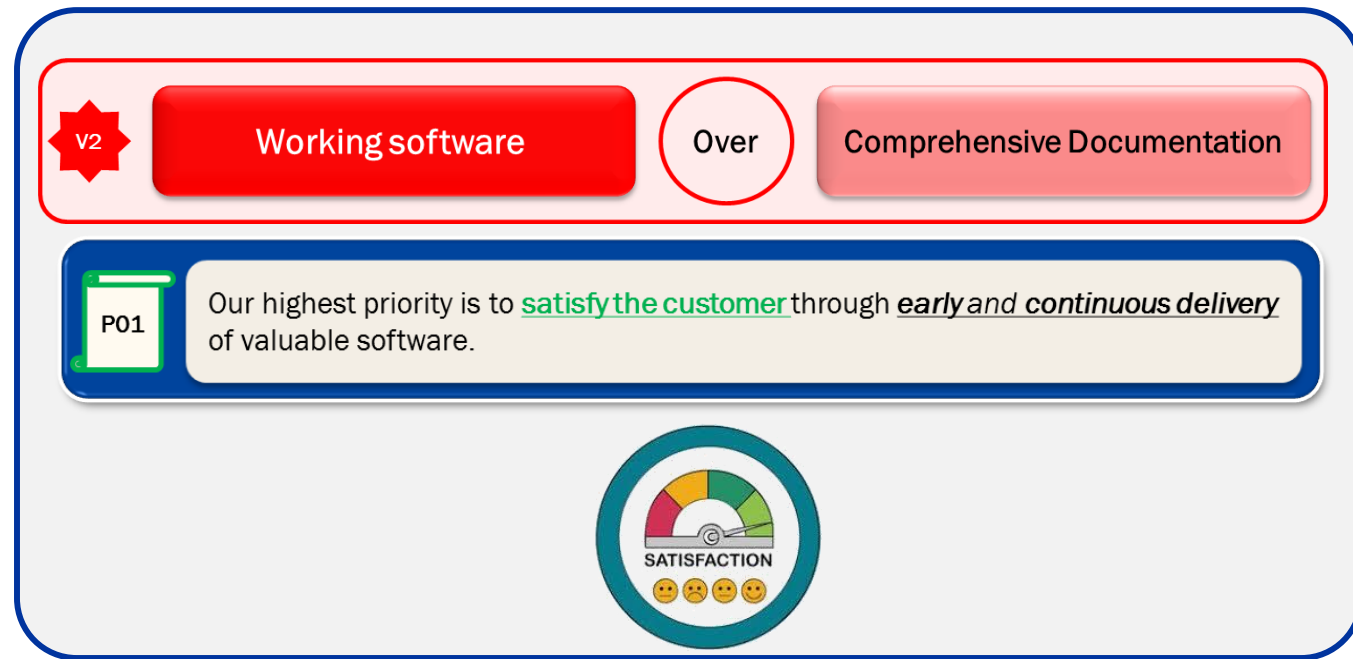

## Agile Values & Principles

Scrum



- “**Valuable**” Everyone on the Scrum team takes it really seriously, and does their best to deliver the most value that they can.
- The **Product Owner** makes sure the Scrum team delivers **value** , He has authority to accept items in the Sprint Backlog as “ **Done** ”—or, if they’re not “Done”, refuse to accept them.
- In **Sprint Review** , all collaborates on maximizing value , so the Scrum team learns directly from the **users and stakeholders** what they think is going to be most valuable. This is really important for planning the next Sprint.

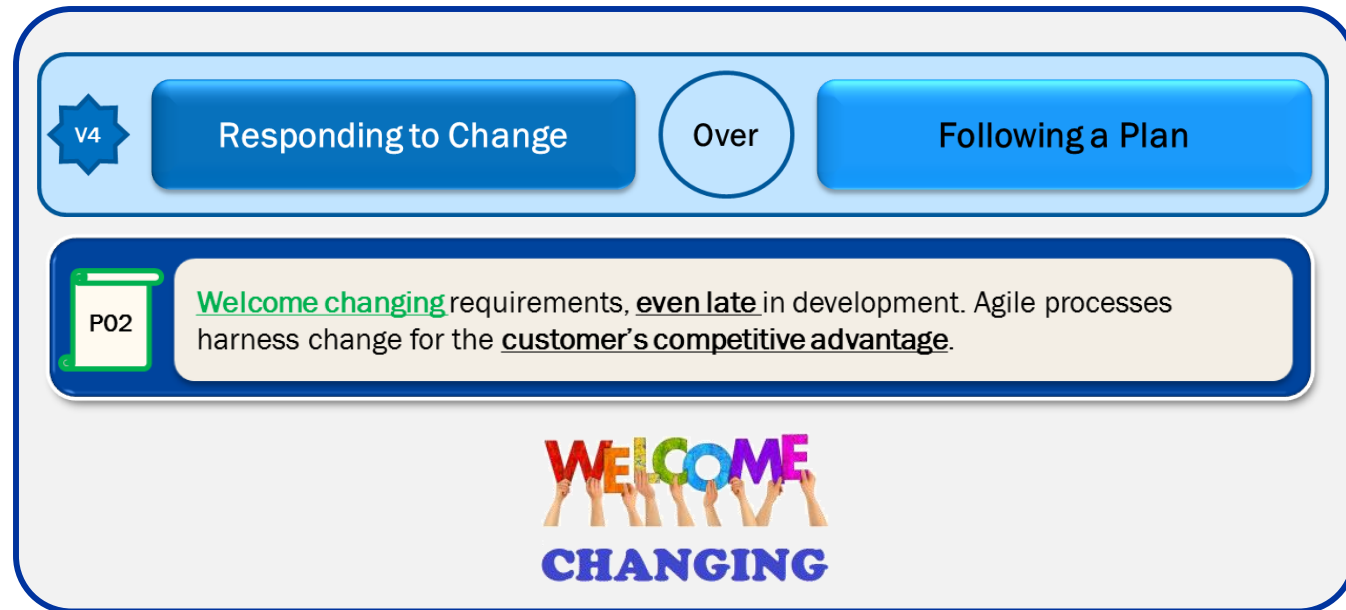

## Agile Values & Principles

Scrum



- In Sprint Review , all Scrum team learns directly from the **users and stakeholders** what they think **and changing requirements** to adhere in the next Sprints.
- They're constantly inspecting and adapting, so they trust themselves to make good decisions in the future.
- Scrum teams **make decisions at the last responsible moment**. They only make project decisions that need to be made now, and leave the rest for later.

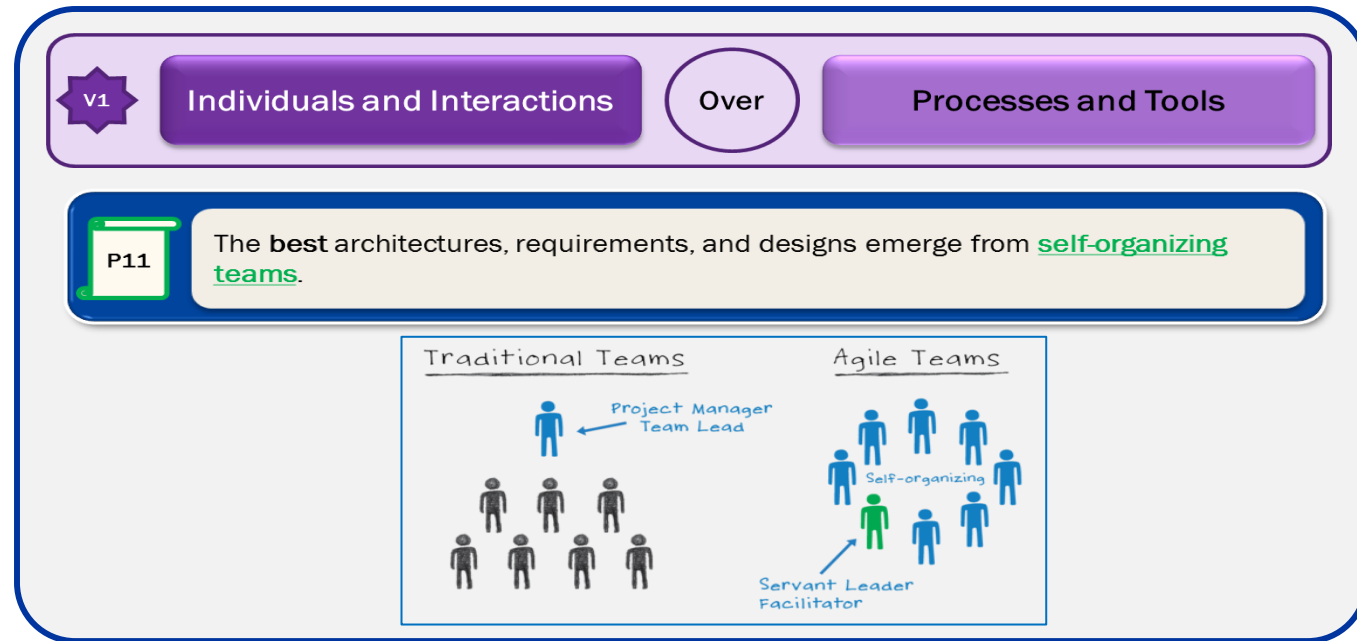

## Agile Values & Principles

Scrum



- **Self-organizing** means **deciding as a team** what to do.
- The whole Scrum team works together to **plan the project**. There isn't a single person building a plan and telling them what to do.
- The Development Team members decide **what will be delivered**, adding new work to the Sprint Backlog as needed. The whole team decides together how they'll **meet those goals**.
- They constantly **adapt their plan** by checking in with each other at the **Daily Scrum**: each person tells the whole team what they're planning on doing next to meet the goals they decided on during Sprint Planning. If a teammate sees a problem with the approach, they'll work together that day to fix it
