
- > "Valuable" Everyone on the Scrum team takes it really seriously, and does their best to deliver the most value that they can.
- The <u>Product Owner</u> makes sure the Scrum team delivers value, He has authority to accept items in the Sprint Backlog as "<u>Done</u> "—or, if they're not "Done", refuse to accept them.
- ➤ In <u>Sprint Review</u>, all collaborates on maximizing value, so the Scrum team learns directly from the users and stakeholders what they think is going to be most valuable. This is really important for planning the next Sprint.





- ➤ In <u>Sprint Review</u>, all Scrum team learns directly from the <u>users and stakeholders</u> what they think and <u>changing</u> requirements to adhere in the next Sprints.
- > They're constantly inspecting and adapting, so they trust themselves to make good decisions in the future.
- > Scrum teams make decisions at the last responsible moment. They only make project decisions that need to be made now, and leave the rest for later.





- > <u>Self-organizing</u> means <u>deciding as a team</u> what to do.
- > The whole Scrum team works together to plan the project. There isn't a single person building a plan and telling them what to do.
- The Development Team members decide **what will be delivered**, **adding new work** to the Sprint Backlog as needed. The whole team decides together how they'll **meet those goals**.
- They constantly <u>adapt their plan</u> by checking in with each other at the **Daily Scrum**: each person tells the whole team what they're planning on doing next to meet the goals they decided on during Sprint Planning. If a teammate sees a problem with the approach, they'll work together that day to fix it
